

Terms and Conditions for GRASP Observers

GRASP, the GLOBALG.A.P. Risk Assessment on Social Practice, is an assessment add-on, consisting of a number of principles and criteria for individual producers and producer groups, plus one additional principle and the respective criteria for producer groups.

GRASP is used to assess social practices in primary production worldwide in combination with certification to a GLOBALG.A.P. primary production standard or equivalent benchmarked scheme/checklist. It focuses on the review of basic indicators of potential social risks on farms.

The main aim of GRASP is to help producers to address important social issues and build awareness at farm level, as well as delivering basic indicators on the performance of the farms in terms of procedures implemented to comply with national/international regulations on labor issues. The level of compliance is determined on a case-by-case basis.

Scope

The following terms and conditions define the rights and obligations of individuals and organizations that have access to the GLOBALG.A.P. IT systems and have been assigned to the data access group "GRASP observer" (hereinafter referred to as "GRASP observers") regarding information related to GRASP that is recorded in the GLOBALG.A.P. IT systems and made accessible to GRASP observers. GRASP observers can only be customers, which are assigned to the data access group "market participant" (see the GLOBALG.A.P. data access rules in the GLOBALG.A.P. document center).

Rights and obligations of GRASP observers

GRASP observers have access to information related to GRASP in the GLOBALG.A.P. IT systems, i.e. GRASP assessment results as defined in the latest version of the GRASP general rules.

The <u>terms and conditions for the use of the GLOBALG.A.P. IT systems</u> apply. The data shall only be used for the internal operation of their organization.

GRASP observers may be granted access to the general GRASP statistics, which they can then access for internal use.
